Buhler was established in 1888, providing goods and services to the immigrant Mennonite farmers who had settled in Little River Township in order to sow the hard red winter wheat seed they had brought with them from Russia. Wheat farming is still the lifeblood of the community.

The 2003 census counted 1,334 Buhler residents, many of whom attend one of three churches within the city limits, and whose children most likely attend either Buhler Grade School or Buhler High School, also located within the city limits.

Relying on the traditional values of personal integrity, respect for others, honesty and dependability, the support of the community helps create an appealing quality of life. Beautiful parks with recreation facilities provide opportunities for leisure activities, and a new residential development boasts new home sites to accommodate families seeking a community with a small town environment, yet large enough to provide most essential services.
